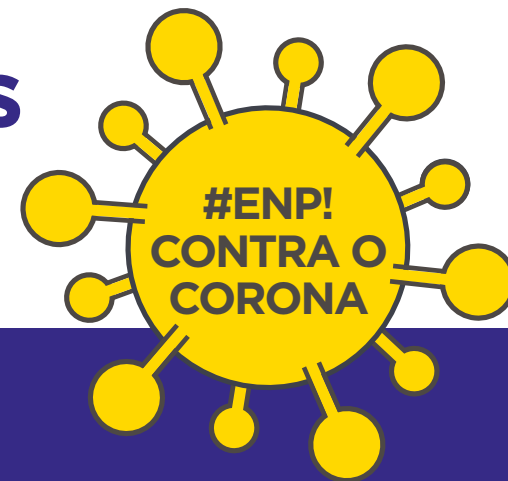


How will São Paulo **state schools** organize the return to class?

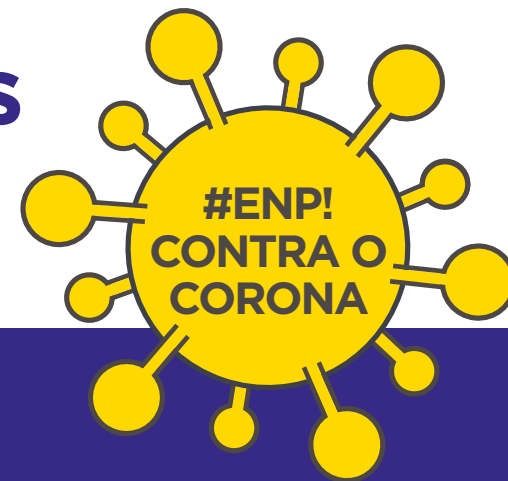


- The São Paulo state school system will restart classes on April 27, through distance learning.
- While face-to-face classes are suspended, students will receive a kit with educational materials in print. They must attend online classes through the digital platform Centro de Mídias de Educação de SP and also through TV channels 2.2 – TV Univesp and 2.3 TV Educação.

How can I receive the printed version of the material?

- The printed materials must be claimed at the schools in which students are enrolled. The exact dates for collecting the material will be arranged by the State Department of Education and Teaching Directories starting on April 27th.

How can I access the digital content?

- The Centro de Mídias de Educação de SP can be accessed online at centrodemidia.sp.educacao.sp.gov.br or through the *Centro de Mídias de Educação de SP* app, available for both Android and IOS systems. Once the app is installed, it does not require an internet connection to browse it.
- To access the digital content, students will have to login with the same username and password used in the *Secretaria Escolar Digital (SED)*.
