So be careful!

## If you experience any of the following situations:

- Working 12, 14 or even 16 hours a day, without regular breaks.
- Being indebted to your superiors due to food, housing or work equipment expenses.
- Being prevented to leave the workplace whenever you want by your superiors.
- Being threatened with deportation.
- Having your documents or salary retained by your superiors.

Do not accept it! This could be **slave labor!**
